AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF CLARK, MERCER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1-88 TO DELETE FROM THE DEFINITION OF "RUBBISH" WOOD, EXCELSIOR, PAPER, TREE BRANCHES AND YARD TRIMMINGS; AND TO LIMIT THE HOURS OF PERMISSIBLE BURNING TO BETWEEN 6:00 A.M. AND 8:00 A.M., AND 4:00 P.M. AND 9:00 P.M. DAILY.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Clark and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT: Ordinance 1-88 is amended in the following respects:

A: Section 1(g) is amended to delete from the definition of "Rubbish" wood, excelsior, paper, tree branches and yard trimmings.

B: Section 2 is amended to add thereto subsection (c):

All open fires not otherwise prohibited by this Ordinance shall be permitted only between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. daily.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY: The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable and, if any of the provisions hereof shall be held unconstitutional, void, or otherwise unenforceable, such shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of said Ordinance.

SECTION 3. REPEALER: All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall become effective the date on which the Mayor shall approve it, or, the date of passage by Council over the veto of the Mayor, or, in the case of any ordinance not returned by the Mayor at the regular meeting of Council occurring at least 10 days after the meeting at which this ordinance was passed by the Council, the effective date shall be the date of such succeeding regular meeting of Council.
