

Minutes of the Clark Borough meeting –January 3, 2023 6:00PM

The meeting of Clark Borough Council was called to order by council President Jim Carucci who led in the pledge to the flag on Tuesday January 3, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. Others in attendance were Maryjo Harakal, Doug Robbins, Cameron McConahy, Larry McKnight, Attorney Tara Rodrigues, Monica Simko and Gregg Sanford.

Doug Robbins made a motion to accept December minutes as written. This motion was seconded by Cameron McConahy and passed with all present voting yes.

Jim Carucci read the Treasurer's Report for the month of December. Larry McKnight made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report. The motion was seconded by Cameron McConahy and passed with all present voting yes.

Jim Carucci read the Payroll Distribution - General Fund Distribution and the State Liquid Fuels Distribution for the month of January. Doug Robbins made a motion to pay the bills as read. The motion was seconded by Cameron McConahy and passed with all voting yes.
